I just want to have a little fun and give you some challenges for you to research on your own. Answer the following questions on your own and see what answers you come up with. *(Without using google)*

- Does the Bible really say that “God helps those who help themselves”?
 - Does the Bible really say that “Cleanliness is next to Godliness”?
 - What does Philippians 4:13 really mean?
 - What “styles” of music for worship are mentioned in scripture?
 - How many times does the Bible say that “Angels” were singing?
 - How does the Bible instruct us on how to handle conflict? (Matthew 18)
 - Does God ever give you more than you can handle? (Why, or why not?)
 - Where did humans come from and what is their purpose?
